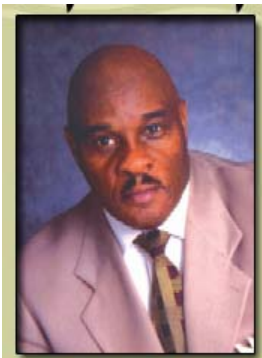

Perryman has drafted legislation requiring congressmen to pay 2x their annual salaries to each and every constituent within their district. The number of co-sponsors for this legislation has set a new record. C.R. 2009 was reviewed in committee and has been recommended to the Senate as a whole.
